Breeding Contract – On Site

This contract is made and entered into this _____, day of _____, 20____, between the (mare owner/agent) _____ and (stallion owner/agent) _____.

Stallion owner/agent is the owner of and controls the breeding rights by and to the stallion _____ reg no. _____. Mare owner/agent desires to have the mare known as _____ reg no. _____, serviced by the stallion.

1. The mare owner/agent agrees to pay a non-refundable (applicable to breeding fee) Booking Fee of \$ _____ to MT Quarter Horses with this contract, and a breeding fee balance of \$ _____. Mare care or boarding will be charged at the rate of \$ _____ per day. Mare care does not include medical and /or veterinary care or farrier services as may be required for the mare. The breeding fee, plus all appropriate unpaid board and expenses, shall be paid to MT Quarter Horses at the time of service or prior to the mare leaving the property/breeding facility of MT Quarter Horses.

2. The mare owner/agent represents and warrants that the mare to be bred is in her broken, healthy, and in sound breeding condition. If registered, a photocopy of the mare's papers, showing both sides, must be furnished and returned with this contract as one of the requirements.

3. The mare owner/agent agrees to have the mare current on deworming and vaccinations and show proof before delivering the mare or MT Quarter Horses will at the mare owner/agents expense provide these services for the mare. (The intra-nasal Strangles vaccine is highly recommended)

4. The mare owner/agent warrants that the mare is free from any infectious, contagious, or transmittable diseases. A negative coggins test is required.

5. The Mare will be delivered to and left at MT Quarter Horses until settled, or returned as many times a necessary during the season. Mares bred as a Haul in lieu of boarding will be charged a daily Haul In or Handling Fee of \$ _____ each time the mare is serviced. All reasonable efforts will be made to settle the mare when present at MT Quarter Horses between the dates of Feb 15, 20____ and June 15, 20____. Should the mare owner fail to deliver the mare for breeding on or before June 15, 20____, MT Quarter Horses will be under no further obligation with respect to this contract.

6. MT Quarter Horses agrees to provide suitable breeding facilities, furnish proper feed, sufficient water and medical and veterinary care as required in a manner consistent with good horse breeding practices, at the mare owners expense. MT Quarter Horses may exercise its own judgement in caring for and supervising the mare and or foal.

7. The mare owner/agent shall bear all the risks of loss from fire, theft, sickness, disease, injury or death or any harm to the mare/or foal. Likewise, the mare owner assumes no liability for injury, sickness, or death of the stallion, owners or employees caused by the mare/or foal.

8. If the mare doesn't settle or does not produce a live foal(one that stands and sucks) the mare owner/agent shall be entitled to return the mare or a substitute mare , approved by MT Quarter Horses, for breeding the following year only, on the terms and conditions provided in this contract, upon payment of that years' booking fee, board and other expenses, but with out any further Breeding Fee. This obligation by MT Quarter Horses to rebreed will only apply if the mare owner/agent notifies MT Quarter Horses in writing within seven(7) days from the birth of a still born foal ar thirty(30) days of a miscarriage. This statement must be accompanied by a statement from a licensed veterinarian verifying such facts. It is agreed that this provision will be of no further effect if the mare is taken to any other stallion before returning to the stallion _____. If the mare owner/agent fails to deliver the mare for rebreeding the following year, any and all fees paid will be forfeited. The right to rebreed under this contract is there by cancelled and MT Quarter Horses is released from any further obligation.
9. If the stallion _____ should die or become unfit for service before the mare produces a live foal, MT Quarter Horses has the option of offering a substitute stallion to breed the mare to or refunding the breeding fee. The breeding fee only shall be refunded to the mare owner/agent by MT Quarter Horses within a reasonable time of receipt of a veterinary certificate stating that the mare is barren or did not produce a live foal. Under no circumstances other than stated above shall the breeding fee be refunded.
10. MT Quarter Horses reserves the right to refuse to breed any mare for any reason.

A breeders certificate will be issued to the mare owner/agent for a foal when MT Quarter Horses has been notified of a live foal and all fees and expenses have been paid in full.</p> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold; color: red;">Sample Contract Only</p> <p>12. The mare owner/agent grants MT Quarter Horses a lien upon the mare and any foal for any unpaid breeding fees, mare care charges, board fees, veterinary charges, or any other charges.</p>

13. The mare owner/agent certifies that he/she is the sole owner of the mare or has full authority to enter into this contract on behalf of the owner.
14. When MT Quarter Horses, by its authorized representative, signs and returns a copy of this contract to the mare owner/agent, it will become a binding contract of both parties. This contract is not transferable or assignable.
